Compensation, and how paid.

such committee to the governor and council, and said report shall be entered on the records of the governor and council and filed in the office of the secretary of state. The compensation of said committee shall be fixed by the governor and council and paid from the contingent fund of the governor and council; and said committee may consist wholly or in part, of members of said council.

Approved February 15, 1883.

Chapter 128.

An Act authorizing the Land Agent to execute in behalf of the State, release deeds in certain cases.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Land agent authorized to give release deeds in certain cases. The land agent is hereby authorized and empowered to give release deeds in behalf of the state, in cases where conditional deeds have been given and the records in the land office show that the conditions have been fully complied with.

Approved February 15, 1883.

Chapter 129.

An Act to facilitate the preparation and issue of the annual report of the State Superintendent of Schools.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Sec. 8, ch. 124, public laws 1873, as amended by ch. 229, public laws of 1880, further amended. SECT. 1. Section eight of chapter one hundred and twenty-four of the public laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-three, entitled "An Act in aid of Free High Schools," as amended by chapter two hundred and twenty-nine of the public laws of eighteen hundred and eighty, is further amended by substituting for the word "December," in the third line thereof, the word 'June,' so that said section shall read as follows:

S. S. committee to make annual returns. 'Sect. 8. The superintending school committee or committees having the supervision of any free high school or schools shall annually, before the first day of June, make returns under oath to the superintendent of common schools,
