Chapter 136.

An Act to amend chapter fifty-five, section one, of the Revised Statutes, in relation to Libraries, Charitable Societies and Public Cemeterics.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The first section of chapter fifty-five of the Sec. 1, ch. 55, R. SECT. 1. revised statutes, as amended by chapter seventy-one of the public laws of the year eighteen hundred and seventy-six, is hereby further amended by inserting the words 'as a relief or benefit association for mutual assistance,' also the words 'as a monument or memorial association,' also the words 'educational, social, military, agricultural, moral, religious,' so as to read as follows, to wit:

'SECT. 1. When seven or more persons desire to be Certain societies, incoporated as the proprietors of a social, military, literary, scientific, or a county law library; as a masonic lodge or chapter of any order or degree; as a lodge of the independent order of odd fellows; as a division of the sons of temperance; as a tent of rechabites; as a grange of patrons of husbandry; as a council of the sovereigns of industry; as a relief or benefit association for mutual assistance; as a monument or memorial association; or as a society to promote in any way the canse of temperance; or for any literary, scientific, musical, charitable, educational, social, military, agricultural, moral, religious or benevolent purpose whatsoever; they may apply in writing to any justice of the peace in the county, and he may issue his warrant, directed to one of said applicants, requiring him to call a meeting of the applicants, at such time and place as the justice appoints.'

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
