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TAXIDERMISTS.

who shall lay before him satisfactory evidence on which to CHAP. 155 sustain the same. It shall be the duty of said inspector or constable to take specimens of suspected butter or cheese and cause the same to be analyzed or otherwise satisfactorily tested. twenty dollars in any one case, shall be included in the costs of prosecution, and taxed and allowed to the officer paying the same.

For the purposes of this act, the terms butter Terms butter and Sect. 5. and cheese shall be understood to mean the products usually known by these names, and which are manufactured exclusively from milk or cream, or both, with salt and rennet, and with or without coloring matter.

Chapter 155.

An Act to repeal chapter one hundred and ninety-two of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-four and section seventeen of chapter fifty of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-eight, relating to taxidermists and all acts authorizing their appointment.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. Chapter one hundred and ninety-two of the Ch. 192, public public laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-four and section seventeen of chapter fifty of the public laws of eightcen hundred and seventy-eight, are hereby repealed.

SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts authorizing the appointment of taxidermists, are hereby repealed.
