Chapter 232.

An Act to amend section one of chapter sixty-five of the Public Laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-six, relating to Telegraph and Telephone Companies

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section one of chapter sixty-five of the public Sec. 1, ch. 65, SECT. 1. laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-six is hereby amended amended. by striking out from the second line thereof the words, " within this state."

SECT. 2. Section one of chapter sixty-five of the public Sec. 1, further laws of eighteen hundred and seventy-six is hereby amended by inserting therein, in the seventh line of said section, between the word "telegraph" and the word "companies," the word 'telephone.'

Chapter 233.

An Act to amend section two of chapter ninety-three of the Revised Statutos, relating to conditional deeds of the public lands.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Section two of chapter ninety-three of the revised statutes, Sec. 2, ch. 93, R.S., amended, is hereby amended by inserting after the word "legislature," in the first line, the words, 'or governor and council,' also by striking out the word "directs," in said first line, and inserting instead thereof the word 'direct,' so that said section, as amended, shall read as follows:
