**Chapter 231.**

An Act to amend Chapter sixty-four of the Revised Statutes, relating to powers and duties of Executors.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section ten of chapter sixty-four of the Revised Statutes, Sec. 10, ch. 64,  
R. S. repealed.  
is hereby repealed.

Approved February 28, 1889.

**Chapter 232.**

An Act relative to the Adoption of Illegitimate Children.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

Section thirty-three of chapter sixty-three of the Revised Sec. 33, ch. 63,  
R. S. amended.  
Statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto the following :  
'If an illegitimate child, and under the age of fourteen years, Consent may be  
given by  
mother.  
such consent may be given by the mother of such child.'

**Chapter 233.**

An Act to establish the salary of the Judge of Probate for the County of Washington.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECT. 1. The annual salary of the judge of probate for Salary of Judge  
of Probate,  
Washington  
county, estab-  
lished.  
the county of Washington shall be six hundred dollars, pay-  
able quarterly from the first day of January, in the year of  
our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighty-nine.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
