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<u>Снар. 57</u> this state; and may also loan on a pledge or mortgage of such other personal property as, in the judgment of the trustees, it is safe and for the interest of the bank to accept. All investments shall be charged and entered on the books of the bank at their cost to the bank, or at par when a premium is paid.'

Chapter 57.

An Act relating to the compensation of the Clerk of Courts in Kennebec County.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Compensation of clerk of courts, Kennebec county, fixed.

SECT. 1. The clerk of courts of Kennebec county shall be allowed attendance the same as provided for clerks in other counties, by chapter three hundred and sixty-five of the public laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-five.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 58.

An Act to repeal chapter two hundred and eighty of the public laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-nine, establishing a bounty on Crows.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Ch. 280, Public Laws of 1889, repealed. SECT. 1. Chapter two hundred and eighty of the public laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-nine, entitled "An Act additional to chapter thirty of the revised statutes, establishing a bounty on crows," is hereby repealed.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
