CHAP. 129

Penalty.

SECT. 2. Any person or corporation violating any provision of this act shall be fined not more than two hundred dollars; and it is hereby made the duty of the insurance commissioner, on the conviction of any person acting as such agent, sub-agent, or broker, to revoke the certificate of authority issued to him at once, for the term of one year.

Ch. 289, Public Laws, 1889, repealed.

SECT. 3. Chapter two hundred and eighty-one of the public statutes approved March nine, eighteen hundred and eighty-nine, is hereby repealed.

Chapter 129.

An Act to amend section eighteen of chapter fifty-one of the Revised Statutes, relating to branch tracks from Railroads.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Sec. 18, ch. 51, R. S., amended.

Section eighteen of chapter fifty-one is amended as follows : by inserting in the third line, after the word "mills" the words, 'mines, quarries, gravel pits,' so that said section as amended, shall read as follows :

Railroad companies may build branch tracks to mills, mines, quarries, gravel pits and factories.

'SECT. 18. Any railroad corporation, under the direction of the railroad commissioners, may locate, construct and maintain branch railroad tracks to any mills, mines, quarries, gravel pits, or manufacturing establishments erected in any town or township, but not within any city through which the main line of said railroad is constructed, without the consent of the city council, and for that purpose said corporation shall have all the powers and rights granted, and be subject to all the duties imposed upon it by its charter.'

Chapter 130.

An Act to amend sections thirty and thirty-one of chapter six of the Revised Statutes, relating to Taxes on stock in Banks and other corporations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Sec. 30, ch. 6, R. S., amended.

SECT. 1. Section thirty of chapter six of the revised statutes is hereby amended, so as to read as follows :
