Chapter 134.

An Act additional to section five of "An Act to amend chapter forty-nine of the Revised Statutes, relating to Insurance."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

He may also license any person as agent of a casualty insurance company to write contracts of accident insurance for the employes of railroads in Maine; all such business to be reported to an agent resident in this state and included in companies to the return of the company as business in Maine.

Insurance commissioner may license agents of insurance write policies employes.

Approved April 3, 1891.

Chapter 135.

An Act in reference to the assessment of Railroad Taxes for the year eighteen hundred and ninety-one.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The time for determining the amount of tax upon railroad companies and reporting the same to the treasurer of state as provided for in section forty-three, chapter six of the revised statutes and acts amendatory thereto, is hereby extended for the year eighteen hundred and ninetyone from the first day of April to the first day of May in said year.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
