Chapter 36.

An Act to confirm the acts and doings of the Hall Signal Company and to allow said company to invest in, hold and sell the stock of other companies.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The acts and doings of the Hall Signal Company, organ- Doings of comized under the general laws of this state, are hereby confirmed, firmed. so far as the same appears of record, and conforms to the purposes of its certificate of organization; and said company is authorized and empowered to purchase, hold, own and sell and use the stock, bonds and property of other corporations, organized under the laws of this and other states, engaged in or relating to, or necessary for the business described in the articles of agreement and certificate of organization of said Hall Signal Company, and may vote upon said stock.

Chapter 37.

An Act to authorize the Baptist Religious Society in North Yarmouth and Freeport, to sell and convey any or all of its real and personal estate.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. The Baptist Religious Society in North Yarmouth society, anthorized to and Freeport is hereby authorized and empowered to sell and sell property. convey any or all of its real and personal estate.

This act shall take effect when approved. SECT. 2.
