SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 63.

An Act to extend the charter of the Bangor Gas Light Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled. as follows :

SECT. 1. The franchise, rights and privileges of the Bangor Gas Light Company, heretofore granted to said company by its charter, are hereby extended for a term of thirty years beyond the period of limitation now fixed by law, subject to the same terms and conditions as therein contained.

Franchise and rights, extended for 30 years.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
