Спар. 269 first day of November in the year of our Lord eighteen hundred and ninety-three.

SECT. 7. Nothing in this act shall deprive the legislature of the right to alter, amend or repeal this charter.

SECT. 8. This act shall take effect when approved. Approved March 21, 1891.

#### Chapter 269.

An Act to authorize the Thomaston Street Railway Company to extend its railroad to Saint George.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

SECT. 1. The Thomaston Street Railway Company is Company, authorized to hereby authorized to construct, operate and maintain a street construct a railroad from Wyllie's corner in the town of Saint George, thence over the county road to the boundary line of Thomas- -route. ton, subject to all the restrictions and limitations of its existing charter and with all the powers and privileges thereby conferred.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

Approved March 21, 1891.

#### Chapter 270.

An Act to amend chapter one hundred and seventy-nine of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-seven of the state of Maine, entitled "An Act for the protection of tront in Cathance Lake, Washington county."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

The fifth line of said chapter is hereby amended as follows: strike out the word "December" and insert instead the word 'June,' so that said chapter shall read as follows:

'If any person shall fish with hook and line, gaff, seine, or with any other tackle in Cathance lake or its tributary brooks or streams in the town of Cooper and Plantation number and June 30, prohibited. fourteen, castern division in Washington county, between the first day of October and the last day of June, he shall forfeit three dollars; and if any person shall take or destroy any \_penalty.
