CHAP. 451

Chapter 451.

An Act authorizing the McKay-Copeland Lasting Machine Company to hold stock and bonds of other corporations.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECT. 1. The McKay-Copeland Lasting Machine Company, a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the state of Maine, which organization is hereby ratified, confirmed and declared to be legal and valid, is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire, hold and dispose of shares of capital stock and mortgage bonds of other corporations.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 452.

An Act in reference to the par value of the shares of stock of the Atwood Lock Company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Atwood Lock
Co., authorized
to change par
value of shares.

SECT. 1. The Atwood Lock Company, a corporation duly established under the laws of the state of Maine, is hereby authorized to change the par value of the shares of its stock from one hundred dollars a share to ten dollars a share, so that the shares of said corporation, instead of being one hundred shares of one hundred dollars each, shall be one thousand shares of ten dollars each. Such change shall be effected whenever a majority of the stockholders of said corporation shall, at a meeting legally called for that purpose, so vote.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
