CHAP. 255 dispose of stock and bonds in other corporations with which it may connect.

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 255.

An Act to amend an act entitled "An Act to incorporate the Carrabasset and Canadian Railroad Company, to authorize the extension of the road of said company, to grant further time for the completion of said road and to change the name of said company.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Route
extended.

SECT. 1. The Carrabasset and Canadian Railroad Company is hereby authorized to extend and construct its railroad by the most feasible route, through the towns of Oakland, Sidney and Vassalboro, the city of Augusta, the towns of Chelsea, Whitefield, Alna and Wiscasset, to some convenient point on tide waters in Wiscasset, and the time to which said corporation is now limited to locate and complete its railroad is hereby extended six years from the approval of this act, and said corporation shall have the same rights, privileges, powers and immunities and be subject to the same duties and liabilities in respect to the portion of the railroad hereby authorized to be extended as are granted and imposed by the original act incorporating said company and acts amendatory thereof. Provided, however, that said corporation before beginning to construct its road through that section of the valley of the Carrabasset river, now occupied by the Kingfield and Dead River Railroad Company, shall first purchase the franchises and plant of said Kingfield and Dead River Railroad Company ; the sum so to be paid, if not agreed between the parties, to be fixed, on application in writing by either party, by the railroad commissioners after notice and hearing.

SECT. 2. Said corporation is authorized to lease or sell all the railroad, franchises, immunities and property which it now has or may at any time hereafter have, to any railroad corporation or corporations which now or hereafter may be incorporated with whose line or lines it does now or may at

any time hereafter connect and to consolidate its stock or management or both, with such corporation or corporations, and to make contracts for the operation or management of the lines of any such connecting corporations and any such connecting corporations may lease or sell their own railroads, franchises, privileges, immunities or property to this, the said Carrabassett and Canadian Railroad Company, and may make contracts for the operation or management of the lines of the latter, and in either event either of the foregoing corporations may respectively accept such lease, sale or contract, provided, however, that no lease or sale of the Carrabassett and Canadian Railroad Company shall be made except on a stock vote of not less than two-thirds of the whole amount of the issued capital stock of the corporation.

SECT. 3. The capital stock of this corporation shall not exceed twelve thousand shares of one hundred dollars each.

Capital stock.

SECT. 4. The name of this corporation is hereby changed from the Carrabassett and Canadian Railroad Company to the Atlantic and Canadian Railroad Company.

SECT. 5. This act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 256.

An Act to amend chapter two-hundred and fifty of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-seven, relating to taking of Alewiv s in Bagaduce River and Walker's Pond.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

SECT. 1. Section one of chapter two hundred and fifty of the private and special laws of eighteen hundred and eighty-seven is hereby amended by inserting after the word "net" in the first line thereof the words 'and weirs,' so that said section as amended, shall read as follows :

'SECT. 1. The taking of alewives, except by hand dip net and weirs between Johnson's Narrows and the head of Walker's or Gray's pond, so called, is hereby prohibited, under a penalty of ten dollars for each fish so taken or caught in violation of this act.'
