within the limits aforesaid by posting up notices in two public places within said limits, seven days at least, before the time of said meeting; and either of said persons may preside at said meeting until after its organization, and until after a moderator shall be chosen by ballot and sworn, and at all meetings of the corporation a moderator shall be chosen in the manner and with the same powers as in town meetings.

When second meeting may be called.

SECT. 12. If this charter is not accepted at the meeting called as provided in section eleven, then either of the persons named in said section may call a second meeting, agreeably to the provisions of this act, for the purpose of further voting on the acceptance of this act, as herein provided.

When act shall take effect. SECT. 13. This act shall take effect when approved by the governor, so far as to empower the first meeting of said corporation to be called; and this act shall take and have complete effect in all its parts when accepted at any meeting of said corporation by a majority vote of the legal voters voting at said meeting.

Chapter 283.

An Act to extend the charter of the Eastport Bridge.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:

Charter extended.

SECT. 1. The charter incorporating certain persons for the purpose of building a bridge uniting the towns of Eastport and Perry, passed June twenty-seventh, eighteen hundred and twenty, being chapter fourteen of the private and special laws of eighteen hundred and twenty, and the right to take toll thereunder, are hereby extended for the term of two years from September twentieth, eighteen hundred and ninety-five; provided, that the rate of tolls to be charged and collected shall not exceed those now charged and collected.

-proviso.

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
