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**Chapter 298.**

An Act to incorporate the Boothbay Harbor Yacht Club.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :*

SECT. 1. N. H. Hussey, R. E. Murray, C. J. Marr, T. L. Montgomery, Harry Fletcher, E. Tibbetts, J. F. Lewis, R. Olson, W. H. Hodgdon, W. T. Marr, W. T. Holton, J. W. Taggart, I. T. Andrews, E. Huff, Jr., M. D. Sawyer, L. A. Dunton, H. Hartung, E. A. Poole, W. Marson, E. L. Porter, C. E. Sherman and Frank L. Rice, and such persons as are now or may hereafter become associated with them are hereby made a corporation by the name of the Boothbay Harbor Yacht Club, having its office in the town of Boothbay Harbor, for the purpose of encouraging yacht building and naval architecture, and the cultivation of nautical science, with all the privileges, and subject to all the duties, restrictions and liabilities set forth in the general laws which are or may be in force, applicable to such corporations.

Corporators.

Corporate name.

SECT. 2. Said corporation may hold real estate to an amount not exceeding in value ten thousand dollars, and personal estate to an amount not exceeding twenty-five thousand dollars.

May hold [real estate.]

SECT. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
