CHAP. 311

Chapter 311.

An Act to make valid the calling of the annual town meeting in the town of Windham for the year eighteen hundred and ninety-five.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Calling of town meeting, legalized.

That the warrant for calling the annual town meeting of the town of Windham, in the county of Cumberland, held on the fourth day of March, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and ninety-five, shall have the same force and effect as if posted in accordance with the provisions of section seven of chapter three of the revised statutes.

Chapter 312.

An Act to amend chapter four hundred and twelve of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-three, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Franklin Telephone and Telegraph Company."

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows :

Sec. 2, ch. 412, Private and Special Laws of 1893, amended.

SECT. 1. That section two of chapter four hundred and twelve of the private and special laws of eighteen hundred and ninety-three, be amended by adding thereto the words 'and to North New Portland and to Madison, in the county of Somerset,' so that said section as amended, shall read as follows :

May own telegraph and telephone line.

SECT. 2. Said corporation shall have the right to own, locate, construct, maintain and operate a telephone and telegraph line from Farmington to any and all points in the county of Franklin, except where there is a telegraph or telephone line now in operation, and to North New Portland, and to Madison in the county of Somerset.

SECT. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.
