Chapter 33.

Resolve in favor of the town of Limerick.

Town of
Limerick, in
favor of.

Resolved, That the state treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to pay to the town of Limerick one hundred ninety-two dollars and seventy-eight cents, the same being to refund to said town the amount paid in state tax for the years eighteen hundred and ninety-three and eighteen hundred and ninety-four, on account of a clerical error in the valuation of said town as returned to the state assessors.

Chapter 34.

Resolve for the purchase of the Maine State Year Book and Legislative Manual for the years eighteen hundred and ninety-five and eighteen hundred and ninety-six.

Resolved, That the secretary of state be authorized to contract for six hundred copies of the Maine State Year Book and Legislative Manual for the year eighteen hundred and ninety-five, also nine hundred copies of the same for the year eighteen hundred and ninety-six to be delivered on or before the first day of May of each year, at a cost not to exceed one dollar and fifty cents per copy. One hundred of said copies for each year to be delivered to the state librarian for the use of the state library, the remainder to be distributed in the usual manner.

Chapter 35.

Resolve to refund certain state taxes on township number four, range five, west of Kennebec river in Somerset county.

Resolved, That the state treasurer is authorized to pay to Elias Milliken, five dollars and sixty-five cents and to the Coburn heirs, thirty-three dollars and sixty-three cents, being the amount paid by them to the state treasurer as part of the amount abated from the state tax on township number four, range five, west of Kennebec river in Somerset county, for the year eighteen hundred and ninety-three.
