CHAP. 37**Chapter 37.**

Resolve in favor of the Canada road.

Canada road,
in favor of.

Resolved, That the sum of two hundred dollars be, and is hereby appropriated to be expended in repairing that part of the Canada road which is in Sandy Bay township, said sum to be expended under the direction of the county commissioners of Somerset county.

Chapter 38.

Resolve in favor of Calais Academy.

Calais
Academy, in
favor of.

Resolved, That the sum of five hundred dollars be and is hereby appropriated annually for two years to aid Calais Academy.

—proviso.

Provided, however, that this appropriation is made upon the express condition that the trustees of said institution shall maintain and keep in operation, for at least twenty-four weeks per year, a school equal in rank and grade of teaching with a first-class academy; and provided further, that the governor and council and superintendent of common schools shall have a right at all times to visit said school, when the same shall be in operation; and if in the opinion of the governor and council, said institution at any time hereafter shall fail to fulfill the conditions contained in this resolve, they may in their discretion, withhold the appropriation herein granted.
