Chapter 39.

Resolve in favor of the Children's Aid Society of Maine.

Resolved, That the sum of three thousand dollars be, and is hereby appropriated from the treasury for the purpose of buying land and buildings, or buying land and erecting buildings, for the use of the Children's Aid Society of Maine, at Belfast, for a home for friendless, destitute and needy children; the same to be expended under the direction of the governor and council. Such real estate to be held by said corporation in trust for the foregoing purpose, and when such home shall be abandoned or the real estate used for any purpose other than that specified, the same shall become the property of the state freed from the trust aforesaid.

Chapter 40.

Resolve in favor of Roads in Indian Township, Washington County.

Resolved, That the sum of six hundred dollars be and is hereby appropriated for repairs of roads and bridges in the Indian township, Washington county, for the year one thousand eight hundred and ninety-five and six hundred dollars for the year one thousand eight hundred and ninety-six. The same to be expended under the governor and council.

Chapter 41.

Resolve in favor of the town of Chesterville for rebate of State Tax.

Resolved, That the state treasurer be directed to refund to the town of Chesterville the sum of two hundred forty-one dollars and eighty-eight cents on account of error in state tax for the years one thousand eight hundred and ninety-three and one thousand eight hundred and ninety-four.
