Chapter 52.

Resolve in aid of repairing a draw bridge in the town of Addison.

Bridge, in
Addison, in
favor of.

Resolved, That the sum of eight hundred dollars be and is hereby appropriated to aid in repairing the draw bridge across Pleasant river in the town of Addison, said bridge to be repaired under the direction of the county commissioners of Washington county, and the amount herein appropriated is to be paid when the governor and council are satisfied that the sum of fifteen hundred dollars has been actually expended for repairs of said bridge by the town of Addison.

Chapter 53.

Resolve in favor of Parsonsfield Seminary of Parsonsfield, Maine.

Parsonsfield
Academy, in
favor of.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of five hundred dollars annually, for the years one thousand eight hundred and ninety-five and one thousand eight hundred and ninety-six, to the use of the Parsonsfield Seminary of Parsonsfield, Maine.

Provided, however, that this appropriation is made upon the express condition that the trustees of said institution shall maintain and keep in operation a school equal in rank and grade of teaching with a first class academy, of not less than three terms of ten weeks each during each year; and provided further, that the governor and council and superintendent of common schools shall have a right at all times to visit said school, when the same shall be in operation; and if in the opinion of the governor and council, said institution at any time hereafter shall fail to fulfill the conditions of this resolve, they may in their discretion, withhold the appropriation herein granted.

Approved March 7, 1895.
