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Chapter 94.

Resolve in favor of the Maine State Prison.

Resolved, That the sum of nineteen thousand dollars be and hereby is appropriated for and in behalf of the Maine State Prison, to be expended under the direction and supervision of the prison inspectors and warden of the state prison, for the following purposes: For paying outstanding indebtedness of the prison and furnish suitable working capital for the manufacturing industries therein, fifteen thousand dollars; for repairs on buildings and wall for eighteen hundred and ninety-five, three thousand dollars; for repairs on buildings for eighteen hundred and ninety-six, one thousand dollars.

Chapter 95.

Resolve in favor of a road in Dallas Plantation.

Resolved. That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars, to be expended under road in, in favor of. the direction of the county commissioners of Franklin county, in completing a road in Dallas plantation, between Rangeley and Dead River station.

Approved March 20, 1895.

Chapter 96.

Resolve in aid of a road in Dallas and Lang Plantations.

Resolved, That the sum of two hundred dollars be and is hereby appropriated for repairing and maintaining the road extending from Dead River station on the Phillips and Rangeley Lakes Railroad, through Dallas and Lang plantations to Coplin plantation in Franklin county; the same to be expended under the direction of the county commissioners.
