## CHAP. 323

‘Sect. 7. Said corporation may be appointed executor, trustee or assignee, with the same powers and duties as are conferred and imposed by law upon natural persons acting in the same capacities and subject to the same control of the courts having jurisdiction of the same, in all proceedings relating to the exercise of these powers; all papers may be signed and sworn to by any officer designated by the corporation for that purpose, and the officers shall be subject to citation and examination in the same manner and to the same extent as natural persons acting in the same capacities. No sureties shall be required upon the bond of the corporation when acting in said capacities, unless the court or officer approving said bond shall require it. Said corporation may become surety upon any bond required to be given by any party in any matter or proceeding in any court or by any person holding any position of trust in which a bond is required; and upon any bond required to be given under any law, or regulation of any department of the government, of the United States.’

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect when approved.

### Chapter 323.

An Act to legalize the lease of the Old Town Street Railway Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in Legislature assembled, as follows:*

Lease made  
valid.

Sect. 1. The lease heretofore made by the Old Town Street Railway Company to the Bangor, Orono and Old Town Railway Company, under the provisions of section thirteen of chapter four hundred and ninety-five of the private and special laws for the year one thousand eight hundred and eighty-nine, is hereby confirmed and made valid.

Franchises  
renewed.

Sect. 2. The franchises heretofore granted to said Old Town Street Railway Company are hereby renewed.

Sect. 3. This act shall take effect when approved.
