Resolve in favor of James Chase, Mail Carrier of the House,

Resolved. That there be and hereby is appropriated to be paid to James A. Chase the sum of thirty dollars for expenses as mail carrier of the House.

Resolve in favor of Sereno T. Kimball, Secretary of the Joint Select Committee on State Printing.

Resolved, That the state treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to pay to Sereno T. Kimball, secretary of the joint select in favor of. committee on state printing, created by joint order passed January five, nineteen hundred and five, the sum of one thousand three hundred forty-nine dollars, the same being for expenses incurred by said committee under a joint order of the Senate and House, passed January nineteen, nineteen hundred and five.

#### Chapter 159.

Resolve in favor of Moses Moon, a Civil War Veteran.

Resolved, That there be paid to Moses Moon a state pension Moses Moon, of six dollars per month from January first, nineteen hundred and five, until such time as he shall receive an increase in his United States pension.
