Chapter 169.

Resolve in favor of the Eastern Maine Insane Hospital.

Resolved, That the sum of twenty-three thousand one hundred and fifty dollars be and is hereby appropriated for and in behalf Hospital, in favor of. Resolved, That the sum of twenty-three thousand one hundred of the Eastern Maine insane hospital at Bangor, for year nineteen hundred and five, and twenty-three thousand one hundred and fifty dollars for the year nineteen hundred and six, for the purpose of meeting current expenses, making repairs and improvements, and purchasing additional land.

Said sums to be expended under the direction of the trustees of insane hospitals.

Approved March 24, 1905.

Chapter 170.

Resolve in favor of Albert W. Buck, Messenger to the President of the Senate.

Resolved, That the sum of fifty dollars be and the same hereby Buck, in is appropriated to be paid to Albert W. Buck, for services as favor of. messenger to the president of the senate.

Approved March 24, 1905.

Chapter 171.

Resolve in favor of the Town of Bristol.

Resolved, That there be paid to the town of Bristol the sum Bristol, in of sixty-seven dollars and fifty cents, which is one-half the outlay in maintaining free high school, that remains unadjusted with the department of schools for the year nineteen hundred and four.
