Chapter 12.

An Act to amend Chapter fifty-five of the Private and Special Laws of Maine for the year nineteen hundred and three, incorporating the Squirrel Island Village Corporation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section five of chapter fifty-five of the private and special laws of Maine for the year nineteen hundred and three is hereby amended by striking out in the fourth line of said section the word "sixty" and inserting in place thereof the word 'seventy-five,' so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

Section 5,

'Section 5. The town of Southport shall annually pay over to the treasurer of said corporation out of the taxes collected from the inhabitants and estates on Squirrel Island a sum equal to seventy-five per centum of all the town taxes, exclusive of the state and county tax, collected from said inhabitants and estates.'

Chapter 13.

An Act to extend the charter of the Mattagamon Manufacturing Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The rights, powers and privileges of the Mattagamon Manufacturing Company which were granted by chapter two hundred and seventy-nine of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred and one and by chapter forty-seven of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred three and by chapter ninety-nine of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred five and by chapter twenty-eight of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred seven are hereby extended, and the persons named in said act, their associates, successors and assigns, shall have all the rights, powers and privileges that were granted them by said acts, to be exercised in the same manner and for the same purposes as specified in said acts.
