Chapter 113.

An Act to extend the charter of the Wells Telephone Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Charter ex-
tended.

The rights, powers and privileges of the Wells Telephone Company, which were granted by chapter three hundred and seven, of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred and seven, are hereby extended for two years from the passage of this act; and the persons named in said act, their associates and successors, shall have all the rights, powers and privileges that were granted them by said act, to be exercised in the same manner and for the same purposes as specified in said act.

Chapter 114.

An Act to extend the charter of the Dixfield Trust Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Charter ex-
tended.

All the rights, powers and privileges of the Dixfield Trust Company which were granted by chapter fifty-two of the private and special laws of one thousand nine hundred and seven, are hereby extended for one year; and all the rights, powers and privileges that were granted by said act, may and shall be exercised in the same manner and for the same purposes as provided in said act; provided, however, that said company shall actually commence business as a trust company within the said one year.
