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**Chapter 7.**

Resolve in favor of the Bar Harbor Medical and Surgical Hospital located at Bar Harbor, Maine.

Resolved, that there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of two thousand dollars to be paid to the Bar Harbor Medical and Surgical Hospital toward the running expenses of said institution for the year nineteen hundred and nine, and two thousand dollars toward the running expenses of said institution for the year nineteen hundred and ten.

Bar Harbor Medical and Surgical Hospital, in favor of.

**Chapter 8.**

Resolve in favor of the Bath City Hospital.

Resolved, that there be and is hereby appropriated the sum of two thousand dollars, to be paid to the Bath City Hospital for the use of said institution for the year nineteen hundred and nine, and two thousand dollars for the use of said institution for the year nineteen hundred and ten, and that there be and is hereby appropriated the further sum of fifteen hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred and nine, and fifteen hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred and ten for repairs and improvements.

Bath City Hospital, in favor of.

**Chapter 9.**

Resolves, authorizing a Temporary Loan for the year nineteen hundred and nine.

Resolved, that to provide for the wants of the treasury, the treasurer of state be and is hereby authorized to procure on the faith of the state, if he shall deem it necessary, at any time during the year nineteen hundred and nine, a temporary loan of three hundred thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be needed.

Temporary loan authorized for 1909.

Resolved, that the treasurer of state be and hereby is authorized to give notes in behalf of the state, payable within two years from the date hereof, for such portions of the loan hereby authorized as may be required.

State treasurer may give notes for.
