Chapter 13.

Resolve in favor of the Official Reporter of the Senate.

Resolved, that there be paid to Edward K. Milliken, the official reporter of the Senate, the sum of three hundred dollars for assistance employed by him at the present session of the legislature.

Edward K. Milliken, in favor of.

Chapter 14.

Resolve in favor of the Electoral College.

Resolved, that there be and is hereby appropriated the sum of three hundred and forty dollars on account of the Electoral College as provided by chapter six, section one hundred and twenty-nine of the revised statutes.

Electoral College, in favor of.

Chapter 15.

Resolve in favor of the purchase of the Maine State Year Book and Legislative Manual for the years nineteen hundred nine and nineteen hundred ten.

Resolved, that the secretary of state be authorized to contract for six hundred and fifty copies of the Maine State Year Book and Legislative Manual for nineteen hundred nine; also for nine hundred fifty copies of same for nineteen hundred ten to be delivered on or before the first day of June each year at a cost not to exceed two dollars per copy. One hundred fifty of said copies for each year to be delivered to the state librarian for the use of the state library, the remainder to be distributed in the usual manner.

Chapter 16.

Resolve in favor of the Children's Hospital.

Resolved, that the sum of forty thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred and nine be and hereby is appropriated for the equipment of the Children's Hospital at Portland, Maine, and the building of an addition thereto;

And that the further sum of five thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred and nine, and ten thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred and ten, be and hereby is appropriated for the maintenance and support of the said institution.
