CHAP. 24

For the year nineteen hundred and ten, for assistance to needy patients, to be used in the discretion of the trustees of said association for charitable purposes in the treatment of patients at said institution, the sum of seven thousand five hundred dollars; to be used in the construction and equipment of new cottage, five thousand dollars.

Chapter 24.

Resolve accepting the benefits of the Carnegie Foundation for the advancement of teaching for the University of Maine.

Resolved, that the application of the board of the trustees of the University of Maine to the trustees of the Carnegie Foundation for the advancement of teaching, for the benefits of the foundation are hereby approved, and said benefits accepted for the University of Maine.

Resolve in favor of a special appropriation for Eastern State Normal School.

Resolved, that a special appropriation of seven hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred and nine and seven hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred and ten, be passed in favor of the Eastern State Normal School at Castine.

Resolve in favor of Saint Elizabeth's Roman Catholic Asylum of Portland.

Resolved, that there be and is hereby appropriated the sum of five thousand dollars to be paid to the Saint Elizabeth's Roman Catholic Asylum of Portland, for the use of said institution; two thousand five hundred dollars to be appropriated for the use of said institution for the year nineteen hundred nine and two thousand five hundred to be appropriated for the use of the said institution for the year nineteen hundred ten.
