Chapter 35.

Resolve in favor of the Augusta City Hospital.

Resolved, that there be and is hereby appropriated the sum of four thousand dollars to be paid to the Augusta City Hospital for the use of said institution for the year nineteen hundred and nine, and four thousand dollars for the use of said institution for the year nineteen hundred and ten.

Be it further resolved, that there be and is hereby appropriated the further sum of two thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred and nine and two thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred and ten for the building fund of said institution.

Approved February 19, 1909.

Chapter 36.

Resolve in favor of the Maine General Hospital.

Resolved, that there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of Maine General Hospital, ten thousand dollars to be paid to the Maine General Hospital for the use of said institution for the year nineteen hundred and nine, and ten thousand dollars to be paid to said institution for its use for the year nineteen hundred and ten.

Be it further resolved, that there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of twelve thousand dollars to be used for the purpose of repairs upon its buildings for the year nineteen hundred and nine.

Chapter 37.

Resolve in favor of Bangor Children's Home.

Resolved, that the sum of fifteen hundred dollars be and hereby is appropriated in aid of the current expenses of the Bangor Children's Home, of Bangor, Maine, for the year nineteen hundred and nine, and the sum of fifteen hundred dollars for the same purpose for the year nineteen hundred and ten.
