Resolve in favor of the Northern Maine General Hospital of Eagle Lake.

Resolved, that there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of two thousand dollars for the use of the Northern Maine General Hospital of Eagle Lake for the year nineteen hundred and nine, and two thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred and ten for current expenses of said hospital.

Chapter 61.

Resolve in favor of the Maine Children's Home Society.

Resolved, that there be and is hereby appropriated the sum of twelve hundred and fifty dollars for the use of the Maine Children's Home Society of Augusta, for the year nineteen hundred and nine, and twelve hundred and fifty dollars for the year nineteen hundred and ten. Should there be any unexpended balance of said appropriation for a particular year, such balance shall not lapse, but may be expended in the year next succeeding.

Resolve in favor of navigation on Sebec Lake.

Resolved, that the sum of two hundred dollars is hereby appropriated for the placing of buoys and maintenance of buoys and lights in Sebec lake for the year nineteen hundred and nine; and the sum of two hundred dollars is hereby appropriated for the placing of buoys and maintenance of buoys and lights in Sebec lake for the year nineteen hundred and ten. All said money shall be expended under the direction of the State Steamboat Inspectors, and any part of the money hereby appropriated which shall be unexpended at the end of the year nineteen hundred and ten shall revert to the state.
