Chapter 112.

Resolve in favor of the town of Trescott.

Resolved, That the sum of five hundred dollars be, and is hereby appropriated; two hundred and fifty dollars for the year nineteen hundred and nine and two hundred and fifty dollars for the year nineteen hundred and ten, to the town of Trescott in maintaining its roads and bridges, said sums to be expended under the direction of the county commissioners of Washington county.

Chapter 113.

Resolve in favor of the town of Bremen.

Resolved, that there be and hereby is, appropriated the sum of sixty-eight dollars to reimburse the town of Bremen in the county of Lincoln and state of Maine for money expended by it during the year nineteen hundred and seven.

Chapter 114.

Resolve in favor of the Maine State Pomological Society.

Whereas, the question of better fruit for Maine is of the greatest importance to our state welfare, now, therefore, be it

Preamble.

Resolved, that there be and is hereby appropriated the sum of one thousand dollars annually, to be paid to the Maine State Pomological Society, this amount to be used by the society for the purpose of promoting the interests of better fruit growing in Maine, by holding an annual exhibition wherein premiums on horticultural products shall be paid, and such field meetings as may be thought profitable by the executive committee, and for the payment of any other incidental expenses thereof; provided, that an itemized account of all moneys expended be rendered each year to the commissioner of agriculture, and upon his approval and the presentation of proper vouchers, said appropriation shall be paid from the state treasury.
