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**Chapter 164.**

Resolve in favor of Lincoln Academy.

Resolved, that there be and hereby is appropriated to be paid to the trustees of Lincoln academy for the use and benefit of that institution for the year nineteen hundred and nine the sum of five hundred dollars, and for the year nineteen hundred and ten the sum of five hundred dollars; the same to be expended for necessary repairs upon the buildings of said institution.
