Chapter 205.

Resolve in favor of the town of Marion.

Resolved, that there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of one hundred and twelve dollars to be paid to the town of Marion to reimburse said town for money expended in support of William Maloney, a state pauper.

Chapter 206.

Resolve in favor of the town of Hodgdon, Aroostook County.

Resolved, that the sum of forty-three dollars and thirty-three cents be and is hereby appropriated to reimburse the town of Hodgdon for supplies furnished to state paupers.

Chapter 207.

Resolve in favor of Roads in Indian Township.

Resolved, that the sum of three thousand five hundred dollars be and hereby is appropriated for the construction and repair of roads and bridges in the Indian township, Washington county, for the year nineteen hundred and nine, and three thousand five hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred and ten. Each of the above appropriations shall be expended in each year as follows:

in aid of.

One thousand dollars for ordinary maintenance and repairs of the roads in said township, and two thousand five hundred dollars for the permanent improvement of said roads; said appropriation to be expended under the direction of the state commissioner of highways.

Chapter 208.

Resolve in favor of the town of Rome.

Resolved, that the sum of twenty dollars be and hereby is appropriated for the purpose of reimbursing the town of Rome for money paid by said town for tuition of a pupil at the Maine Wesleyan seminary, same being one-half the amount actually paid by said town.
