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**Chapter 222.**

Resolve in favor of screening Spring River Lake situated partly in Washington County and partly in Hancock County.

Resolved, that the sum of two hundred dollars be and is hereby appropriated for the year nineteen hundred and ten, to be paid out of the general appropriation for the operation of the fish hatcheries and feeding stations for fish and for the protection of fish, for the purpose of screening Spring River lake, so called, situated partly in Washington county and partly in Hancock county, to be expended under the direction of the commissioners of inland fisheries and game, when the balance necessary to erect said screen, as found by the commissioners, shall have been raised by the inhabitants of the county of Washington, and paid into the treasurer of state for this purpose.

Provided, further, that this appropriation shall not be available until the town of Cherryfield shall have, in legal town meeting, and having an article in the warrant for said town meeting for that purpose, by vote of record, voted to assume all liability for the keeping of said screen at all times free from sticks, leaves and all debris, so that the same will not become clogged and prevent the free running of the water through the same.

**Chapter 223.**

Resolve in favor of the Western State Normal School.

Resolved, that there be, and hereby is appropriated the sum of two thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred and nine, and the sum of three thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred and ten for the Western State Normal School at Gorham, the same to be expended by and under the direction of the trustees of the normal schools of the state.

**Chapter 224.**

Resolve in favor of the town of Frenchville for one hundred forty-one dollars and seventy-five cents, to be paid to the town of Frenchville on account of State Road constructed in nineteen hundred and eight.

Resolved, that the sum of one hundred forty-one dollars and seventy-five cents be and hereby is appropriated to reimburse the town of Frenchville on account of state road constructed in the year nineteen hundred and eight.
