#### Chapter 235.

Resolve in favor of the town of Dresden in aid of the repair and maintenance of Bridges.

Bridges in town Dresden, in aid of. Resolved, that the sum of five hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred and nine, and five hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred and ten be, and is hereby appropriated to be paid to the town of Dresden for the repair and maintenance of bridges. Said money shall be expended by or under the supervision of the selectmen of the town of Dresden with the approval of the county commissioners.

Approved March 24, 1909.

#### Chapter 236.

Resolve in favor of the Town of Island Falls in the County of Aroostook in aid of building a bridge across the West Branch of the Mattawamkeag River.

Town of Island Falls, in favor of Resolved, that the sum of two thousand five hundred dollars be, and hereby is appropriated for the purpose of assisting said town of Island Falls in the construction of a steel bridge across said West Branch of the Mattawamkeag river, and that the same be paid when the county commissioners shall certify to the governor and council that said bridge has been completed at a cost not less than five thousand dollars.

Approved March 24, 1909.

### Chapter 237.

Resolve in favor of State aid for the Support of the Eastport Bridge.

Eastport Bridge state aid for. Resolved, that the sum of one thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred and nine, and one thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred and ten, is hereby appropriated for the purpose of aiding the city of Eastport in repairing the wooden bridge across tide waters between the city of Eastport and the town of Perry in Washington county; provided the town expends a like amount.
