Chapter 238.

Resolve in favor of the County of Penobscot.

Resolved, that there be, and hereby is appropriated the sum of two thousand two hundred and thirty-four dollars, and forty-seven cents to reimburse the county of Penobscot for expenditures made in the maintenance of bridges between Old Town and Milford under the provisions of chapter four hundred and two of the private and special laws of nineteen hundred and seven.

Chapter 239.

Resolve in favor of the town of Rangeley.

Resolved, that the sum of fourteen dollars and forty-one cents be, and is hereby appropriated for the purpose of reimbursing the town of Rangeley for money paid on account of Mary Bubbier, a state pauper.

Be it further resolved, that the sum of fifty-nine dollars and twenty-nine cents, be and is hereby appropriated for the purpose of reimbursing the town of Rangeley, for money paid on account of William Thomas, a state pauper.

Be it further resolved, that the sum of one hundred and eighty-two dollars and seventy-five cents, be and is hereby appropriated for the purpose of reimbursing the town of Rangeley, for money paid on account of John Donovan and family as state paupers.

Chapter 240.

Resolve in favor of the town of Perham.

Resolved, that the sum of one hundred and twenty-five dollars be appropriated to reimburse the town of Perham, in the county of Aroostook, for money expended by it during nineteen hundred and seven, and nineteen hundred and eight, for medical attendance furnished Stephen August, a state pauper.
