CHAP. 273**Chapter 273.**

Resolve in favor of aiding the building of a bridge in the town of Franklin, Hancock County.

Resolved, that there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of ten thousand dollars, to aid in the construction of a bridge across the Narrows, so called, in the town of Franklin; said sum to be paid by the state treasurer to the state highway commissioner, to be expended under his direction. Provided, however, and on condition that the towns of Franklin and Sullivan raise a like sum jointly within two years from the date in which this resolve becomes a law.

Chapter 274.

Resolve for renewal of Insurance Policies on State Property.

Resolved, that the sum of three thousand dollars be and hereby is appropriated for the renewal of expiring insurance policies on state property.

Chapter 275.

Resolve in favor of repairing the Road between Seboomook and Pittston Farm.

Resolved, that there be, and hereby is appropriated the sum of seven hundred and fifty dollars to aid in repairing the road leading from Seboomook, in Somerset county, to Pittston farm. The sum to be expended upon that portion of the road which lies between Seboomook, so called, and Pittston farm. The sum to be expended under the direction of an agent to be appointed for that purpose by the governor and council.
