**Chapter 281.**

Resolve in favor of Susan Baker.

Resolved, that there be paid to Susan Baker, widow of Forbes Baker, late of Steuben in Washington county, the sum of four dollars per month, payable quarterly, from the fund appropriated for military pensions and to begin July first, nineteen hundred and nine.

**Chapter 282.**

Resolve in favor of the Senate Postmaster.

Resolved, that there be and hereby is appropriated the sum of sixty dollars to be paid the postmaster of the senate for expenses incident to the office.

**Chapter 283.**

Resolve in favor of Clerk to the Joint Special Committee on Salaries and Fees.

Resolved, that there be appropriated and paid to A. P. Norton, one hundred fifty-seven dollars and ten cents for services and expenses as clerk to the joint special committee on salaries and fees.

**Chapter 284.**

Resolve in favor of M. H. Hodgdon, Clerk and Stenographer and Messenger to the Committee on Inland Fisheries and Game.

Resolved, that the sum of two hundred dollars be and is hereby appropriated, to be paid to M. H. Hodgdon for services as clerk, stenographer and messenger to the committee on inland fisheries and game during the present session.
