**Chapter 4.**

CHAP. 4

An Act Additional to Chapter Thirty-two of the Revised Statutes, as Amended by Chapter Two Hundred Six of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred Thirteen, Relating to Ice Fishing in Little Dyer's Pond, in the Town of Jefferson, in the County of Lincoln.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

No person shall fish for, take, catch or kill any kind of fish at any time on or through the ice in Little Dyer's pond, so-called, in the town of Jefferson, in the county of Lincoln. No person shall have in possession any kind of fish taken on or through the ice in violation of any provision of this act. Whoever violates any provision of this act shall pay a fine of not less than ten dollars nor more than thirty dollars and costs of prosecution for each offense, and in addition thereto, one dollar for each fish taken, caught, killed or had in possession in violation of any provision of this act.

Ice fishing prohibited.

**Chapter 5.**

An Act to Amend Section Two of Chapter Thirty-two of the Revised Statutes, as Amended by Chapter Two Hundred Six of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred Thirteen, Relating to Ice Fishing in Certain Ponds in Oxford County.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

So much of section two of chapter thirty-two of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter two hundred six of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred thirteen, as prohibits fishing through the ice, in accordance with the general law of the State relating to ice fishing, in Webber pond in Sweden, Dan Charles and Cushman ponds in Lovell, Horseshoe pond in Lovell and Stoneham, Little pond in Sweden, Shell pond in Stow, and Black pond in Fryeburg, all in the county of Oxford is hereby repealed.
