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Chapter 124.

CHAP. 124

An Act to Amend Section Ten of Chapter One Hundred Sixteen of the Revised Statutes, Relating to the Compensation of Fish Wardens.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section ten of chapter one hundred sixteen of the Revised Statutes is amended by inserting after the word "dollars" in the first line thereof the words 'and fifty cents,' so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Section 10. The pay of fish wardens shall be two dollars and fifty cents a day and expenses when actually employed; the Governor and Council shall audit their accounts, and cause the same to be paid from the State Treasury.'

Chapter 125.

An Act to Amend Section Twenty-five of Chapter Forty-seven of the Revised Statutes, Relating to Returns of Lists of Stockholders in Banks to the Secretary of State.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section twenty-five of chapter forty-seven is hereby amended by striking out the last sentence thereof, so that said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Section 25. Such cashiers shall, between the first day of November and the eighth day of December, annually, make return to the Secretary of State of the names of all stockholders, their residences, the amount of stock owned by each and the whole amount of stock paid in on said first day of November.'

Chapter 126.

An Act to Repeal Chapter Sixty-three of the Public Laws of Nineteen Hundred Seven, Providing for Filing Lists of Heirs in the Registry of Deeds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Chapter sixty-three of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred seven, providing for filing lists of heirs in the registry of deeds, is hereby repealed.
