CHAP. 103

Chapter 103.

An Act to Repeal Certain Private and Special Laws, Relating to Use of Motor Boats in Hunting Sea Birds, Duck and Water Fowl on the Coast of Maine.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Certain chapters of Private and Special Laws repealed.

Section 1. Section eight of chapter four hundred seven of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred three is hereby repealed.

Section 2. Chapter two hundred forty-two of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred five is hereby repealed.

Section 3. Chapter two hundred forty-eight of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred nine is hereby repealed.

Section 4. Chapter forty-five of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred eleven is hereby repealed.

Chapter 104.

An Act to Repeal Chapter Three Hundred Seventy-three of the Private and Special Laws of Nineteen Hundred Seven, Relating to the Protection of Ducks in Lincoln County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Ch. 373, P. & S. Laws 1907, repealed.

Chapter three hundred seventy-three of the Private and Special Laws of nineteen hundred seven, relating to the protection of ducks in Lincoln county, is hereby repealed.

Chapter 105.

An Act to Repeal Chapter Fifty-six of the Private and Special Laws of Nineteen Hundred Seven, Entitled, "An Act to Regulate the Use of Certain Roads in the Town of Bluehill."
