Chapter 164.

Resolve in Favor of the Madawaska Training School for Permanent Improvements and Repairs.

Resolved, That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of the Madawaska Training School, at Fort Kent, the sum of one thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred fifteen, and the sum of one thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred sixteen; said sums to be expended under the direction of the Trustees of the State Normal Schools for permanent improvements and repairs at said school.

Chapter 165.

Resolve Providing for the Appointment of Delegates to the Conferences of the National Tax Association, and for the Payment of Their Actual Expenses.

Resolved, That the Governor, by and with the consent of the Council, be, and hereby is, authorized and empowered to appoint not more than three delegates to represent the State of Maine at any conferences of the National Tax Association which may be held during the years nineteen hundred fifteen and nineteen hundred sixteen. Such delegates shall serve without compensation, but their actual expenses, as allowed by the Governor and Council, shall be paid from the State Treasury.
