Resolve Providing a State Pension for Mary Harmon.

Resolved, That there be paid to Mary Harmon of Bangor the sum of ten dollars per month, payable quarterly from the fund appropriated for military pensions, beginning January first, nineteen hundred fifteen and continuing during the pleasure of the Legislature.

Chapter 194.

Resolve in Favor of Maine Central Institute for the Maintenance of the Courses of Instruction.

Resolved, That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, for the use of the Trustees of the Maine Central Institute at Pittsfield, the sum of one thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred fifteen and the sum of one thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred sixteen; said sums to be expended by said trustees for the maintenance of the courses of instruction in said institute.

Resolve in Favor of Freedom Academy for Equipment and Repairs.

Resolved, That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of five hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred fifteen, and the sum of five hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred sixteen, both sums to be paid to the Trustees of Freedom Academy, and expended by them for equipment and for repairs on the dormitory and recitation hall.
