Chapter 174.

Resolve, in Favor of the Chaplains of the Senate of the Eighty-fourth Legislature.

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of one hundred and eighteen dollars to be paid to the chaplains of the senate of the eighty-fourth legislature, in accordance with the list filed with the treasurer of state, having been certified to by the secretary of the senate.

Resolve, to Appropriate Money for the Payment of the Account of William E. Brown, a Member of the State Highway Police.

William E. Brown, payment of claim. Resolved: That there be appropriated three hundred and forty dollars and eight cents to be paid to William E. Brown to compensate him for amount due him on motorcycle mileage while acting as state highway police officer.
