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Chapter 27.

AN ACT Increasing the Amount to be Paid for Clerk Hire in the Office of the Recorder of the Municipal Court of the City of Portland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 125, sec. 46; relating to Portland municipal court clerk hire, amended. Section forty-six of chapter one hundred twenty-five of the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out in lines five and six of paragraph four, after the words "Portland municipal court", the following words, "nineteen hundred seventy-six dollars" and inserting in place thereof the words 'twenty-four hundred ninety-six dollars', so that said paragraph so far as it refers to the amount to be paid for clerk hire in the office of the recorder of the Portland municipal court, shall read as follows: 'for clerks in the office of recorder of the Portland municipal court, twenty-four hundred ninety-six dollars.'

Chapter 28.

AN ACT to Increase the Amount to be Paid for Clerk Hire in the Office of Register of Deeds, in the County of Cumberland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 125, sec. 46; relating to clerk hire in offices, amended. The second line in paragraph four of section forty-six of chapter one hundred twenty-five of the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out the words "thirteen hundred" and inserting in place thereof the words 'fourteen hundred and four', so that said paragraph four, as amended, in so far as it relates to the annual amount to be paid to the deputy register of deeds in Cumberland county, shall read as follows:

'Cumberland county clerk hire increased. Deputy register of deeds, fourteen hundred and four dollars.'
