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RESOLVES

OF THE

STATE OF MAINE

As Passed by the Eighty-Fifth  
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seventy-two thousand dollars, for the year nineteen hundred thirty-one, for the construction and equipment of one additional wing for the segregation and treatment of disturbed and violent patients, to the third wings of the stone buildings, to be expended under the direction of the board of state hospital trustees, with the approval of the governor and council; said funds to be taken from surplus revenue construction fund.

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### Chapter 119.

**RESOLVE, Providing for a Statue of Hannibal Hamlin to be Placed in the National Statuary Hall at Washington.**

Statue of Hannibal Hamlin, contract authorized. Resolved: That the governor and council be, and are, hereby authorized to contract with some suitable artist, a native of Maine, for a statue of Hannibal Hamlin, in bronze, to be placed in the National Statuary Hall at Washington, and that a sum of money not to exceed eight thousand dollars be and hereby is appropriated for the year ending June thirtieth, nineteen hundred thirty-two to carry out the provisions of this resolve.

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### Chapter 120.

**RESOLVE, in Favor of the Townships of Township One, Range Nine, Township Two, Range Nine, Township Two, Range Ten, and Township Three, Range Ten, Piscataquis County.**

Sourdnahunk road; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of five thousand dollars for the fiscal year ending June thirty, nineteen hundred thirty-two, to aid in the repair and maintenance of the Sourdnahunk road in and across said townships, all these townships in Piscataquis county. The money appropriated shall be taken from the general highway fund.

**RESOLVE, in Favor of Township No. 10, Hancock County.**
