### Chapter 36.

**RESOLVE, Relating to Fishing in Matthews Pond in the Towns of Hebron and Oxford.**

Length of trout taken regulated in Hebron and Oxford. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation establishing the legal length of trout taken from Matthews pond, located in the towns of Hebron and Oxford in Oxford county, at 10 inches.

### Chapter 37.

**RESOLVE, Relating to Fishing in Rum Brook.**

Rum brook closed to fishing. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation closing to all fishing Rum brook in Piscataquis county.

### Chapter 38.

**RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Cambolasse Pond.**

Fishing in Cambolasse pond, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation opening to fishing under the general law, Cambolasse pond in the town of Lincoln, in Penobscot county.

### Chapter 39.

**RESOLVE, Relating to Rabbit Hunting in Vinalhaven.**

Close time on rabbits in Vinalhaven. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation making the close time for rabbit hunting within the town of Vinalhaven from February 1 to November 1 of each year.

Approved March 11, 1933
