**Chapter 57.**

**RESOLVE, in Favor of Bion M. Rhoades, of Topsfield.**

**Bion M. Rhoades compensated. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$25, as compensation in full, to be paid to Bion M. Rhoades, of Topsfield, for damage to his crops done by deer, to be paid from the appropriation for the maintenance of the department of inland fisheries and game.

**Chapter 58.**

**RESOLVE, in Favor of Gerald Lund.**

**Gerald Lund, of Marion, compensated. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$16.55, to be paid to Gerald Lund, of Marion, to compensate him for a fine that was imposed on him by error, to be paid from the appropriation for the maintenance of the department of inland fisheries and game.

**Chapter 59.**

**RESOLVE, Relative to Opening of Dole's Pond and Boyd's Pond in the Town of Limington in the County of York.**

**Dole's pond and Boyd's pond opened to fishing. Resolved:** That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Dole's pond and Boyd's pond in the town of Limington in the county of York, to fishing in accordance with the general law of the state and the special laws of York county.
