Chapter 89.

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Libby Brook, in Fort Fairfield.

Fishing in Libby brook, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby directed to issue a rule and regulation, closing to all fishing for a period of 3 years Libby brook in the town of Fort Fairfield in the county of Aroostook.

Chapter 90.

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for William H. Rankin of Winterport.

Pension provided for William H. Rankin. Resolved: That a pension of \$12 per month be, and hereby is, granted to William H. Rankin, of Winterport, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

Chapter 91.

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Susie E. Simmons of Belfast.

Pension provided for Susie E. Simmons. Resolved: That a pension of \$12 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Susie E. Simmons, of Belfast, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Cassie E. Spencer of Winterport.

Pension provided for Cassie E. Spencer. Resolved: That a pension of \$18 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Cassie E. Spencer, of Winterport, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1933, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.
